Re: Conflict Minerals

As a result of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the Conflict Minerals rules recently adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”), many companies, including certain of our customers, are required to make disclosures regarding whether “conflict minerals” used to manufacture their products originated in the Democratic Republic of Congo or the adjoining countries. These “conflict minerals” consist of tantalum, tin, gold and tungsten (collectively, the “Conflict Minerals”).

Westbrook Manufacturing (Westbrook) has conducted a reasonable country of origin inquiry regarding the sourcing of Conflict Minerals contained in the materials from which our products are manufactured. Based on these inquiries, Westbrook is not aware of the inclusion of any Conflict Minerals in these products that would require a finding of not “DRC conflict free” (as defined by the applicable SEC rules). Westbrook will continue working with our suppliers to assure that Westbrook products are “DRC conflict free.”
