California's Proposition 65, also known as the "Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act," entitles California consumers to special warnings for products that contain chemicals known to the state of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm if those products expose consumers to such chemicals above certain threshold levels. We at Westbrook Manufacturing care about our customers' safety and hope that the information below helps with your buying decisions.

Westbrook Manufacturing produces items made from carbon steel, stainless steel, and other specialty steel alloys which may contain nickel, chromium, and/or cobalt which are elements known to the State of California to cause cancer. We believe that because the elements in the steel are in the form of a "stable alloy" they should not constitute a hazard to humans in their original manufactured state. In this form these products are not considered to be hazardous according to OSHA Hazard Communications 2012 (29 CFR 1910.1200). Solid metallic products are generally classified as "articles" and do not constitute hazardous materials in solid form.

We do not add, or cause to be added, any nickel (or any other listed element) to any product we manufacture. However, there are certain processes which might be applied to our products by a downstream end user such as sawing, grinding, drilling, milling (among others) which would potentially release the hazardous element and expose an individual to potential harm. Our products are intended for use in industrial PVF settings and not in commercial or direct to consumer applications.
